Wood Township

Wood was named in honour of the Hon. E. B. Wood who was in parliament for south Brant. The township remained united with Medora from 1873 until the new District Municipality was formed in 1971.


Five school sections were organized in Wood Township.

S. S. No. 4. Morrison Lake

The fourth Wood Township school section was organized in the southeastern portion of the township around Morrison Lake. A frame building was used in this section when the school was closed in the mid 1930's, however, it has since been moved from the school site.

 This area is southeast of Southwood close by the Morrison boundary line.

Morrison Lake teachers since 1911: David Henry, 1911; Mary Walker, 1912; Mary Lee, 1913; Mina Bell, 1914; Cecelia McCabe, 1915; Beulah Bell, 1916-17; Teresa McQuire, 1918; Evelyn Green, 1919; Hattie Styles, 1920; Rhoda Norrie, 1921-23; Mabel Kellar, 1924; Brock Armstrong, 1925-26; D. McRoberts, 1927; Loretta Caisse, 1928-29; Jessie Utter, 1930; Miza Jenner, 1931; Clara Tobin, 1932.



LET'S TAKE CARE OF MORRISON LAKE!

DO:

- Buy phosphate-free soaps, shampoos, cleansers and detergents (especially dishwasher detergent)
- Maintain a natural shoreline with trees and bushes that absorb nutrients before they reach the water
- Buy biodegradable products
- Make sure all wastewater goes through your septic system
- Use environmentally safe cleansers or natural alternatives.
- Call your Municipality and ask about the disposal of paint, paint thinners, oils, wood preservatives, and poisons
- Check all gas and oil storage tanks regularly for leaks and always use a funnel near water.
- Keep it natural avoid using pesticides and herbicides

DON'T:

- Bathe or shampoo in the lake
- Use fertilizers anywhere near the water
- Alter the natural shoreline by adding sand or other fill
- Bury household hazardous materials or pour them down the drain.
